If you would like to present an Abstract, please send your Abstract which shows the presentation idea with short description (200 – 300 words) to: stene.kristiansen@qualitynorway.no

If you do not have any specific paper to submit, but would like to suggest a topic, please present your idea to us by **August 15th**.

If, after evaluation by the Committee, your Abstract is accepted, you will receive a confirmation from us by **August 30th**. After approval, the finished presentation (in a PPT or PDF format, including information regarding the use of animations, videos or specific presentation software) shall be delivered at least **one week** before the conference for the final review by the Committee.

Please note the presentation should not be commercial, however one commercial slide is accepted.

Abstracts are welcome on other subjects that authors believe would be of interest to the offshore crane and lifting community.
